

# Installing Gurung Khema Keyboards

This page provides the instructions for downloading and installing the Gurung Khema Keyboard.

The Gurung Khema Keyboard installs differently from other Translation Commons Keyboards. Please follow the instructions provided here.

This keyboard supports writing in the Gurung Khema script.

- The ISO 15924 script code for Gurung Khema is **Gukh**.
- The ISO 639 language code for this language is **gvr**.

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## Installing Gurung Khema Keyboard on Windows

The files for the Gurung Khema Keyboard and font for Windows are in a file GurungKhemaWindows.zip located <here>.

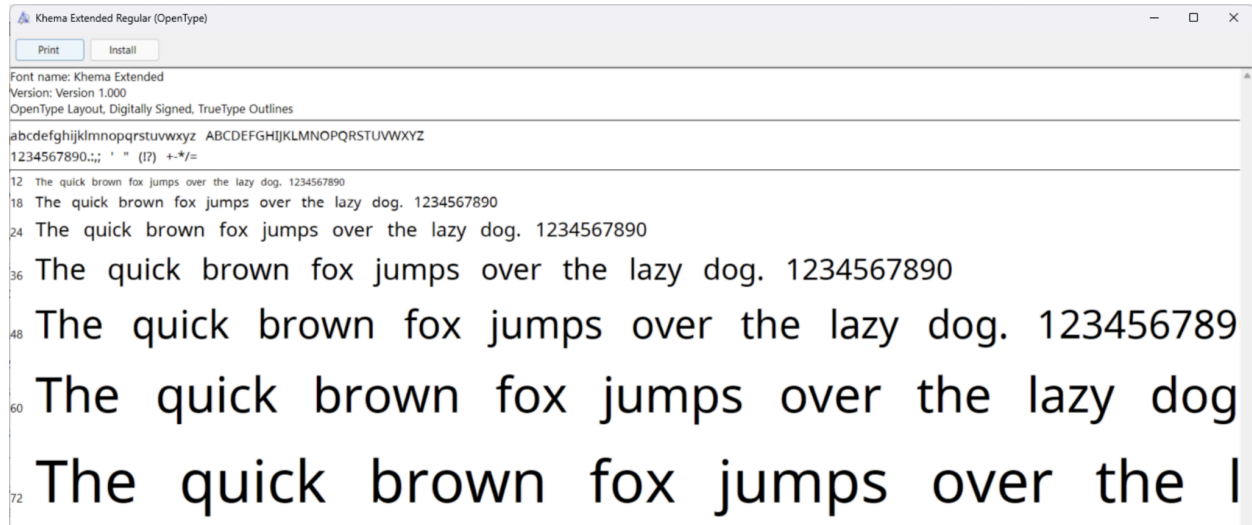
- Download the zip file to your computer.
- Right click on the zip file and select “*Extract All...*”
- This will extract 2 files to a folder.

The keyboard file is an executable file: **KbdEditInstallerGurungKhema-020326.exe**. There is also a font file: **Khema\_extended.ttf**.

**First, install the extended font file:**

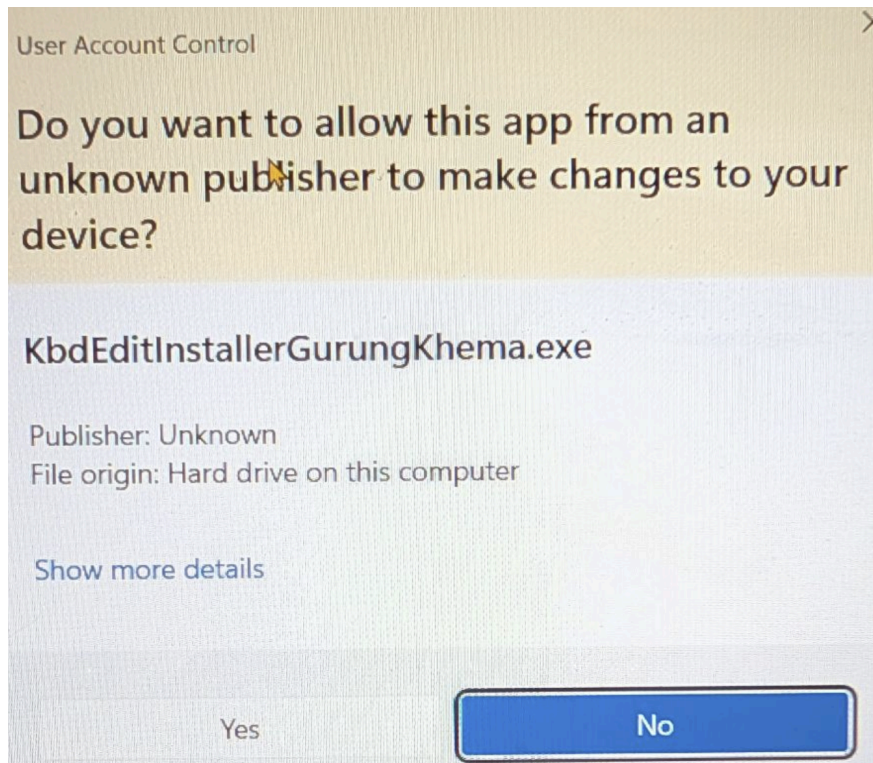
- Right click on the **Khema\_extended.ttf** file
- Select *open with Windows Font Viewer*
- Select *Install* in the pop-up window

The Windows Font Viewer will show a screen like the following:

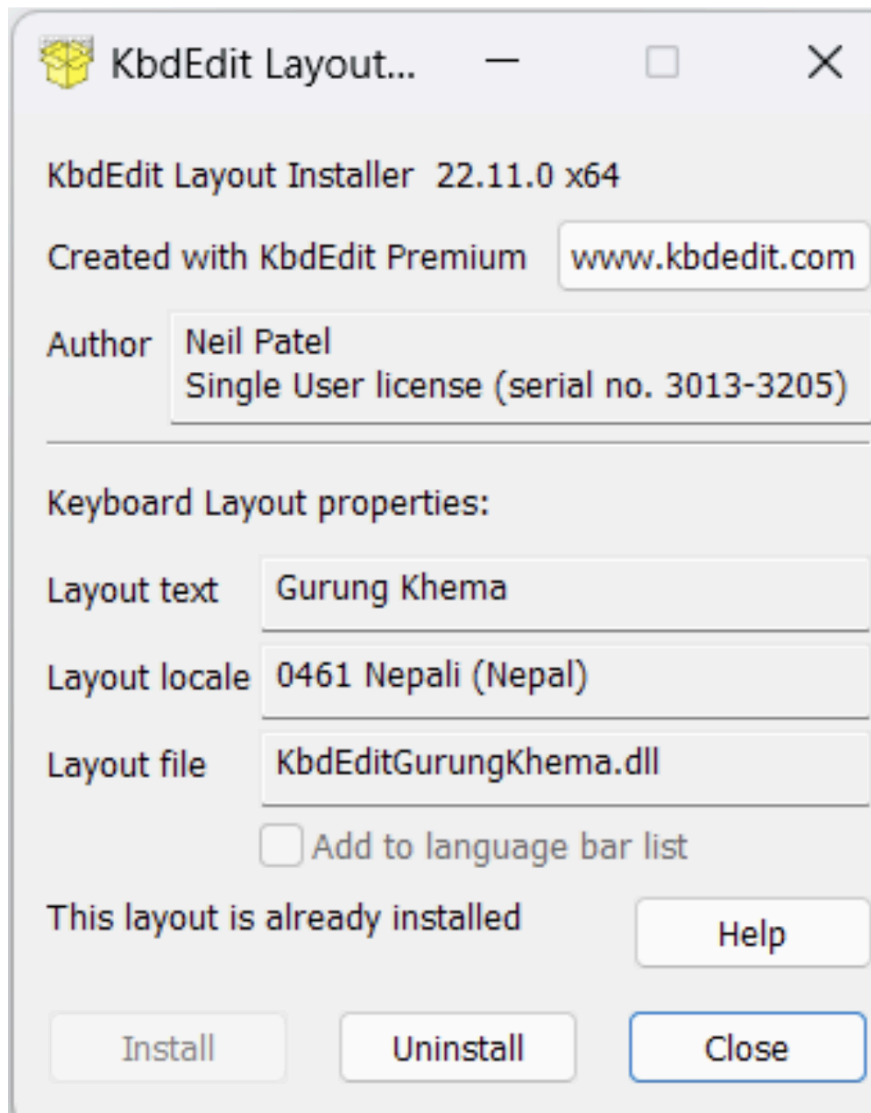


The steps to install the keyboard are as follows:

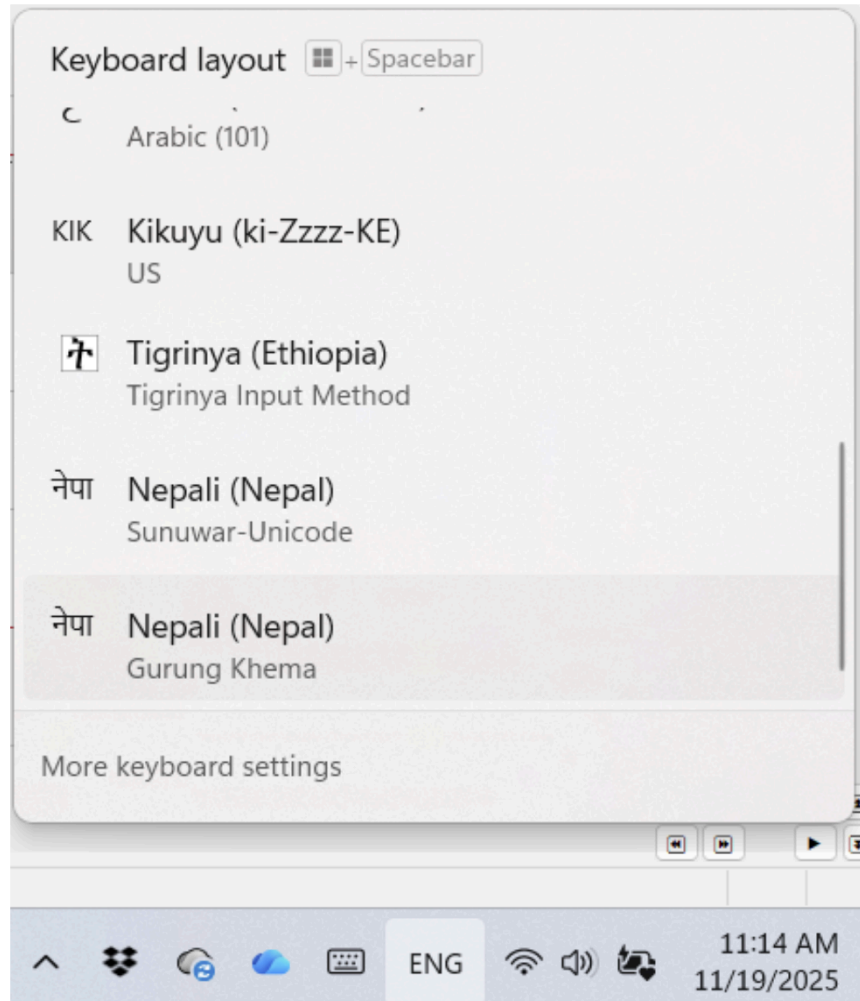
- *Double click* on the **KbdEditInstallerGurungKhema.exe**.
- Select **Yes** to the dialog box asking for confirmation.
- The font will appear as **Khema Extended** in Word, and other applications.



- Make sure the *Add to language bar list* option is not checked



- Select *Install*.
- Now Reboot your computer. This step is required to activate the keyboard.
- The Gurung Khema keyboard is now accessible from the task bar.



The figure shows ENG (English) as the current language on the task bar. Clicking there brings up the keyboard options, which will include the Gurung Khema keyboard. Selecting that keyboard will switch to using it for the current application.

# Installing Gurung Khema Keyboard on MacOS

## Files

- The file to install the Gurung Khema Keyboard for MacOS is the **Gurung Khema.bundle** located <here>.
- The required font file is **Khema\_extended.ttf** located <here>.

## Install the Gurung Khema Font

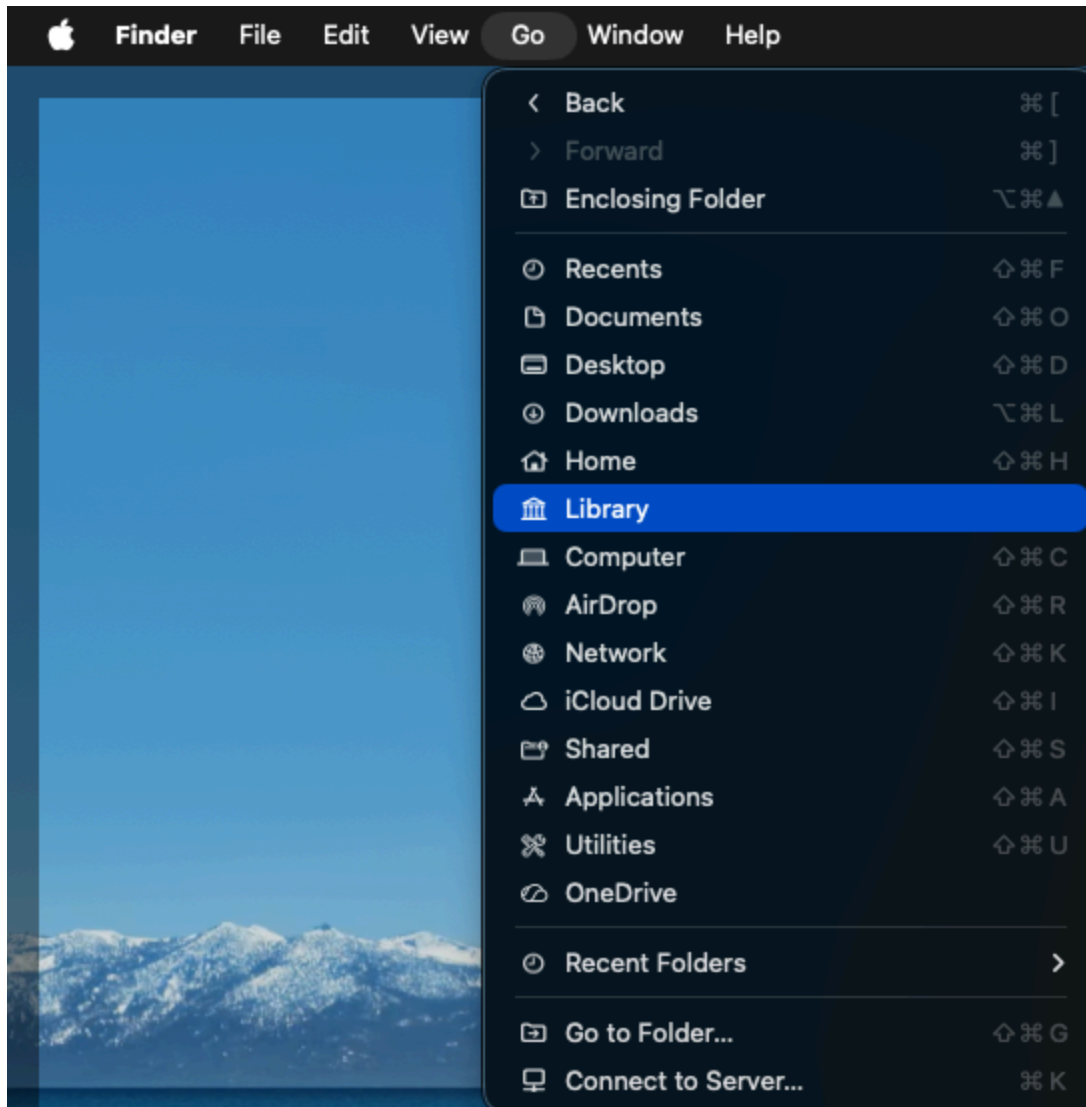
- Download **Khema\_extended.ttf** (located <here>).
- Double-click this font file in the Finder.
- Click [Install](#) in the dialog that appears.

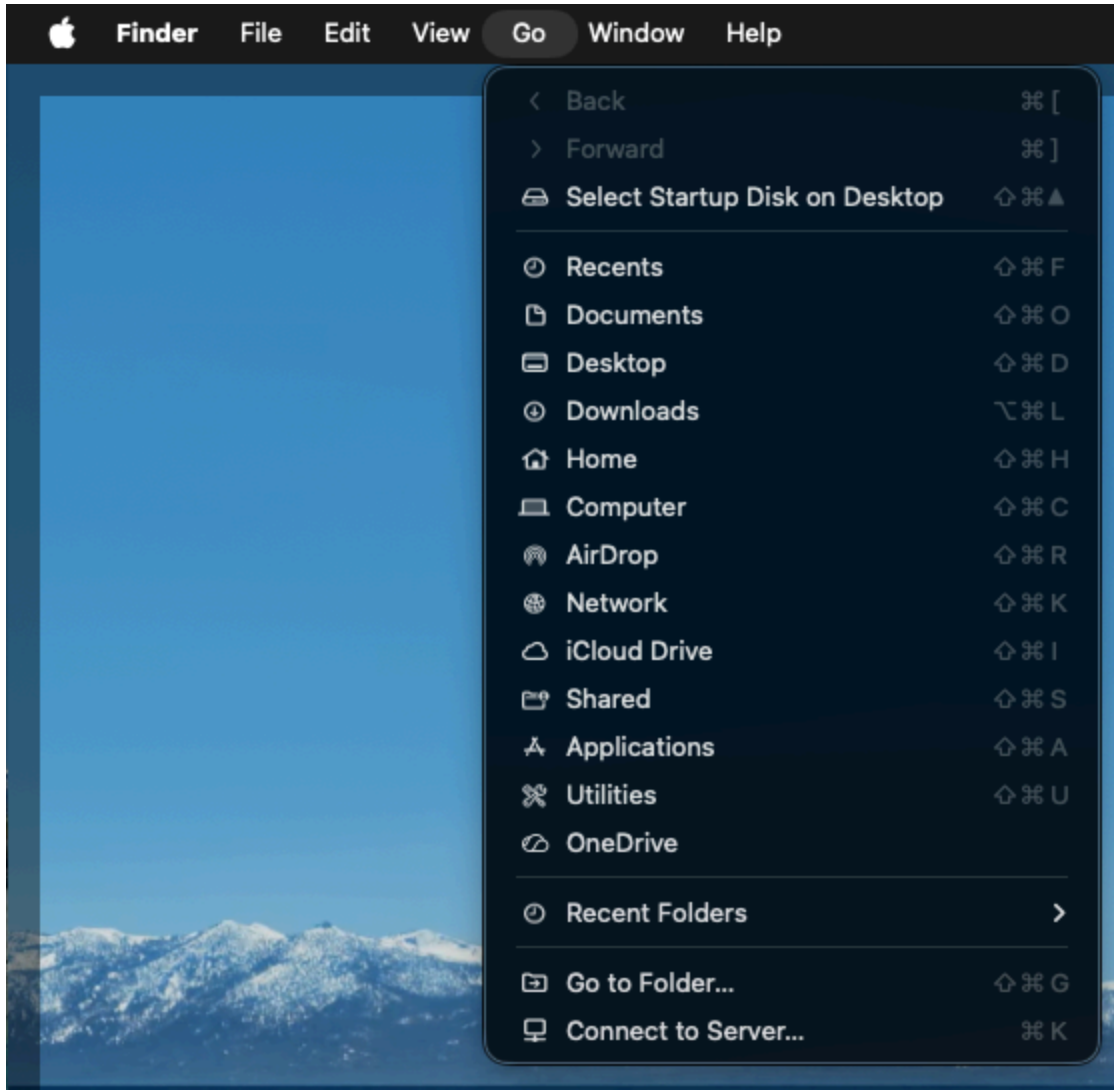
## Install the Keyboard

The steps to install the keyboard are as follows:

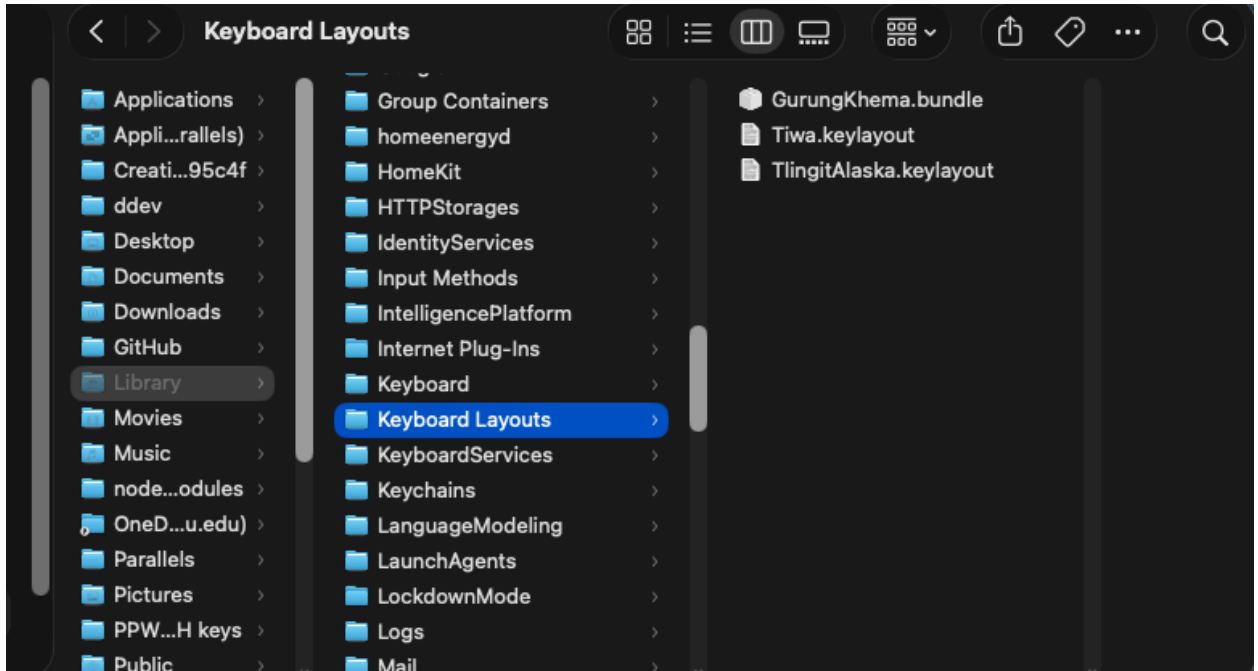
- [Launch](#) Finder (it may be easiest to do this by opening a new finder window).
- [Launch](#) Finder and [select](#) “Go”.
- In the “Go” dropdown menu, [select](#) “*Library*”.



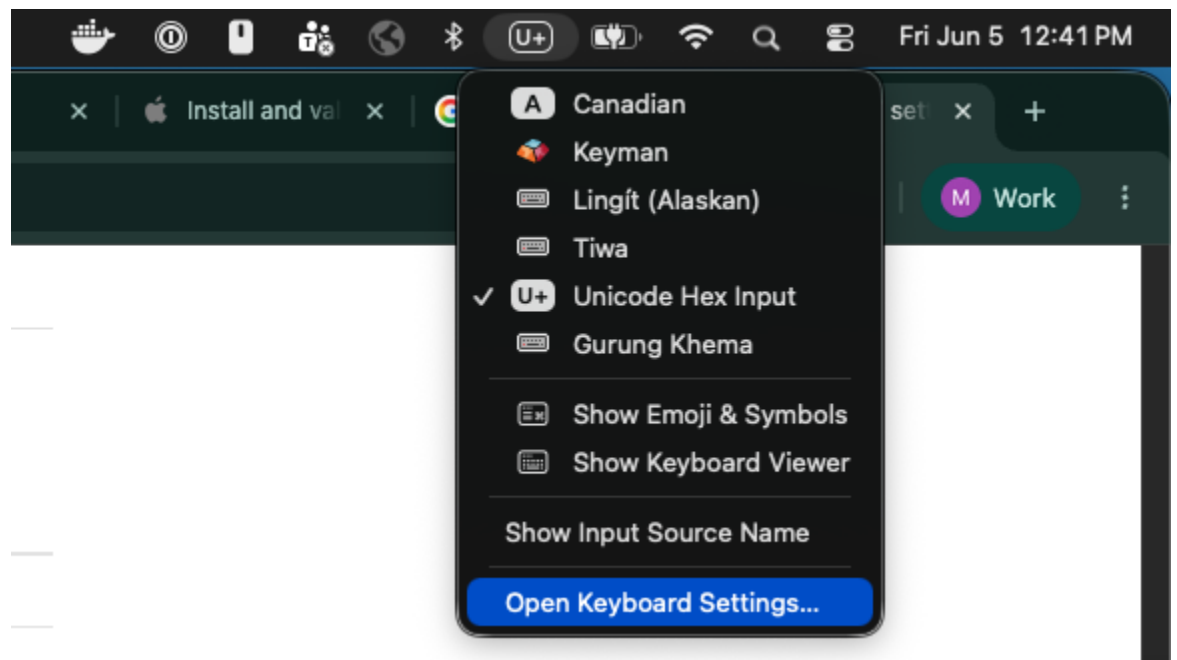
- If you do not see “*Library*” listed in the menu, the folder may be hidden. [Hold the option key](#) to make it appear.

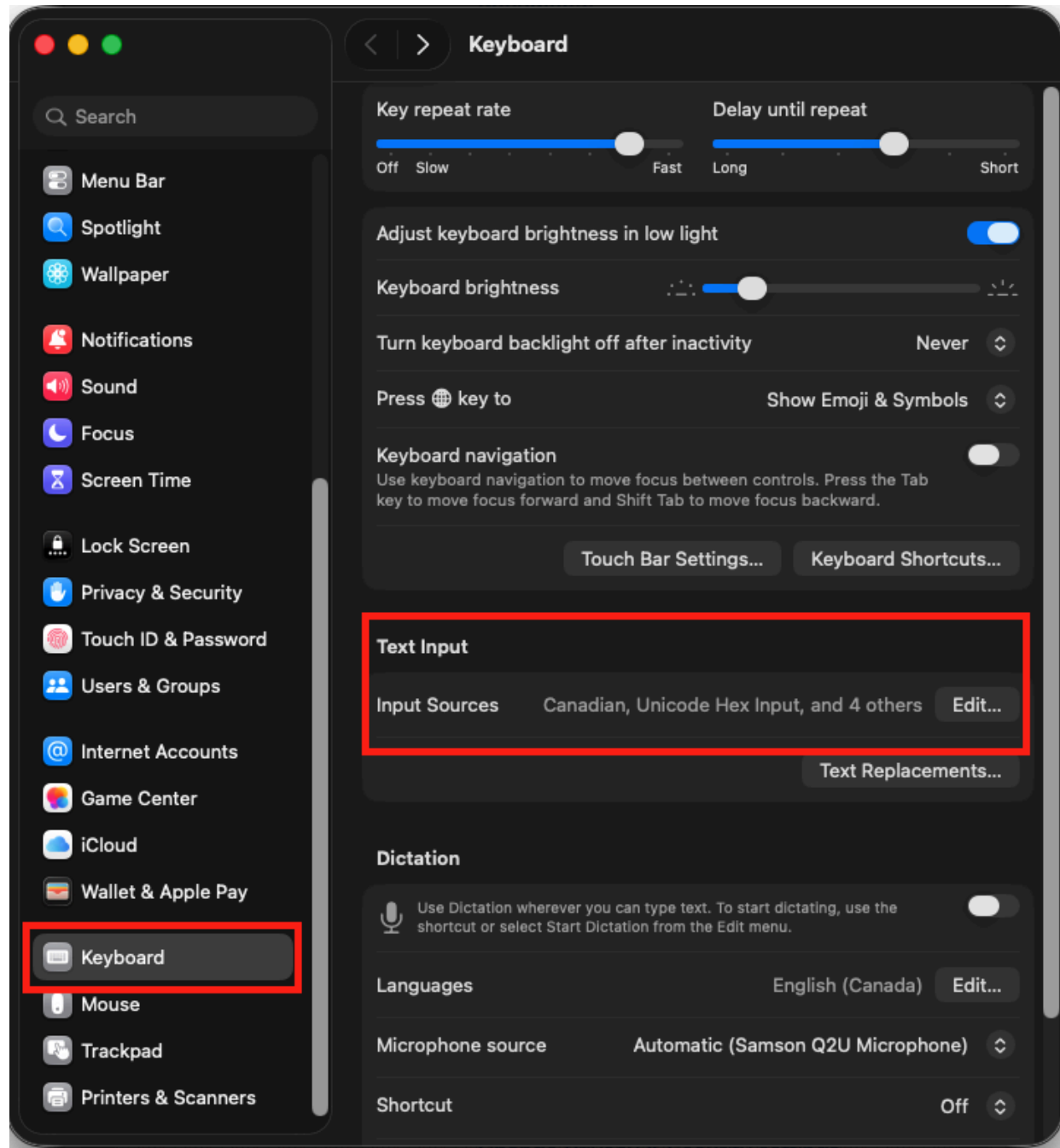


- [Select Library](#)
- [Open Keyboard Layouts](#) folder.
- [Copy Gurung Khema.bundle](#) into [Keyboard Layouts](#)

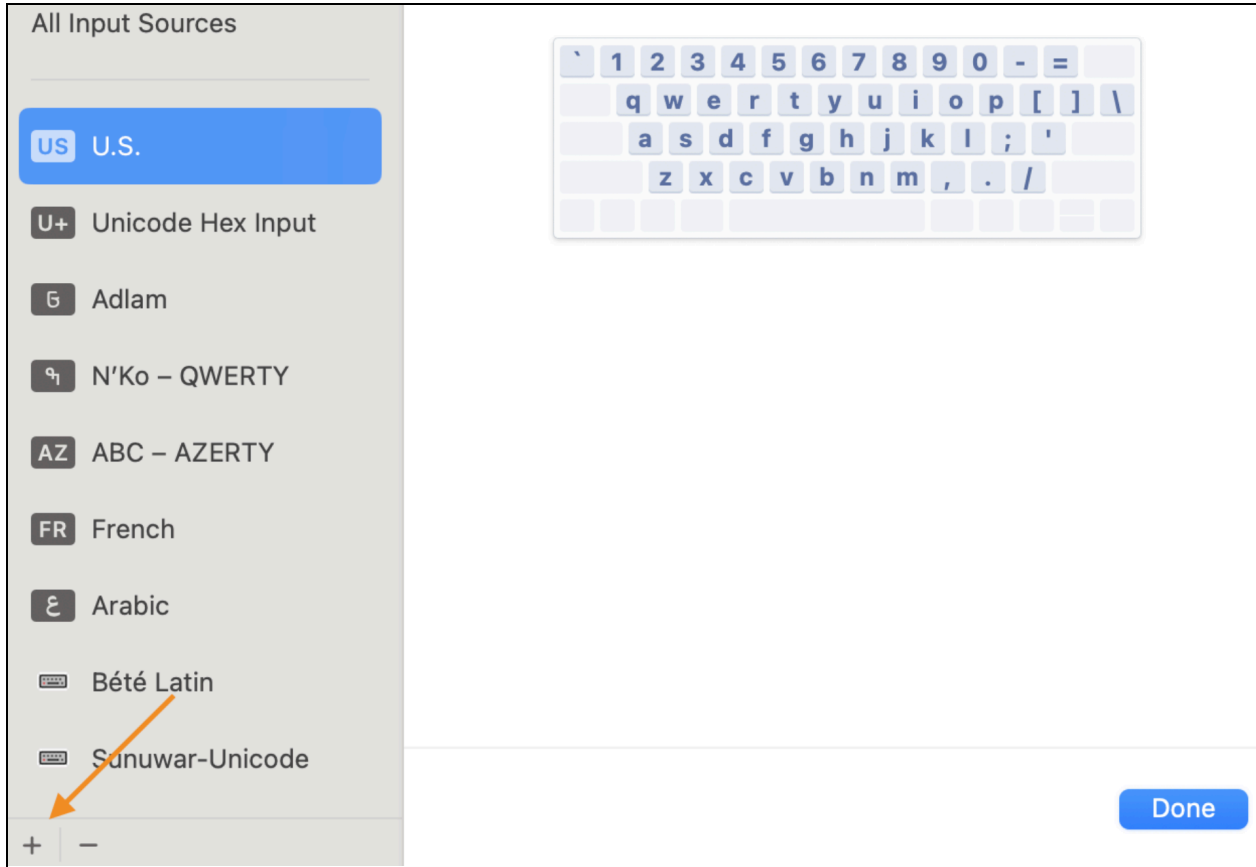


- **Refresh your macOS user profile** by either logging out and back in, or by restarting your computer.
- **Open Keyboard Settings**
  - Either from the keyboard and language icon in your taskbar, or *System Settings > Keyboard > Text Input > Input Sources*

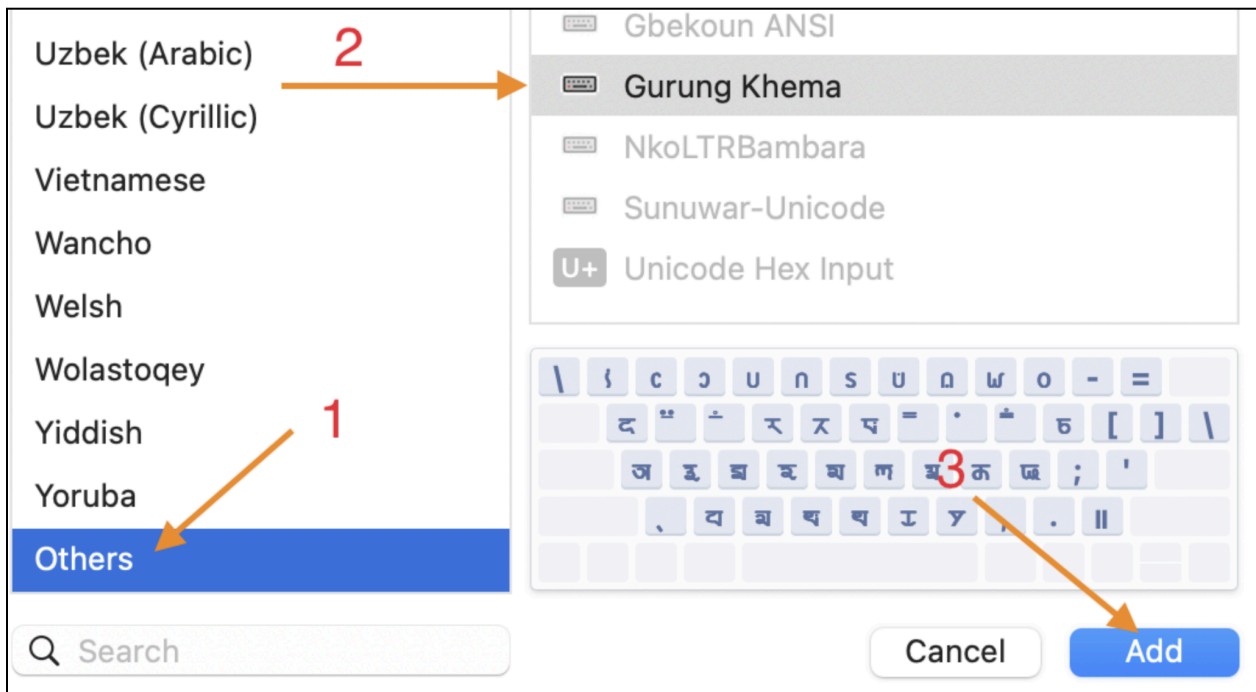




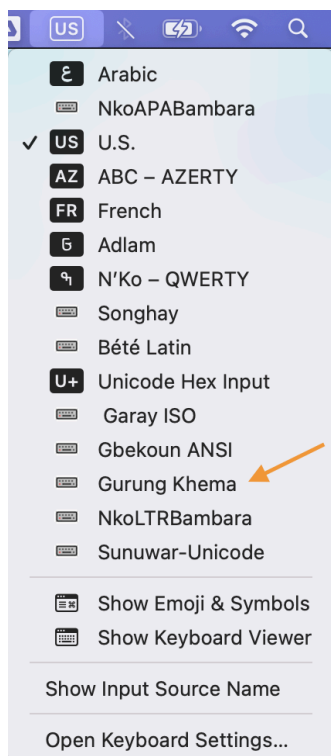
- Select “+” in the lower left corner



- Scroll down to *Others*
- Select *Gurung Khema* and then *Add*



- The keyboard should now be accessible from the task bar.
  - If it is not listed, [refresh your macOS user profile](#) by either logging out and back in, or by restarting your computer.
